## KEYNOTE SPEAKER

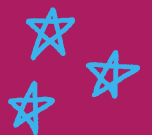

SWAGAA was Crossroads International's first partner organization in Eswatini and the first to implement girls' empowerment programming at a national scale in the country.

With more than three decades of leadership advancing women's rights, Ms. Dlamini has championed initiatives that protect girls, support survivors of abuse, and embed empowerment programming within national education systems. She also served as the first woman Member of Parliament and Chairperson of the Women's Caucus in Eswatini.



Since 2012, the International Day of the Girl Breakfast has brought Canadians together to stand with the **millions of girls** facing gender-based violence, poverty, and the denial of their basic rights.
